Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- Account: A unique account created to access Smithtek services.
- Company ("We", "Us", "Our"): Smithtek Pty Ltd, Perth 6000, Western Australia.
- Cookies: Small files stored on your device that track browsing activity.
- Country: Western Australia, Australia.
- Device: Any internet-connected device such as a computer, smartphone, or tablet.
- Personal Data: Any information that identifies an individual.
- Service: Refers to the Smithtek website and related services.
- Service Provider: Any third party processing data on behalf of Smithtek.
- Third-Party Social Media Service: Platforms that allow users to log in or create an account via

external services.

- Usage Data: Data collected automatically (e.g., IP addresses, browsing behavior, session duration).
- Website: Smithtek, accessible at www.smithtek.com.au.
- You: The individual or entity accessing or using the service.

2. Collecting and Using Your Personal Data

- Usage data

Usage Data

Usage data is collected automatically and may include:

- Device IP address
- Browser type and version
- Pages visited, visit time, and session duration
- Mobile device identifiers and diagnostic data

3. Tracking Technologies & Cookies

Smithtek uses tracking tools such as:

- Cookies: Small data files stored in your browser to enhance user experience.
- Web Beacons: Pixel tags embedded in emails and web pages for tracking interactions.

4. Use of Your Personal Data

Smithtek may use personal data for the following purposes:

- Service maintenance and monitoring.
- Account management.
- Contract fulfillment and transactions.
- Customer communication (e.g., service updates, marketing notifications).
- Analysing usage trends to improve our platform.
- Security and fraud prevention.
- Business transfers and restructuring.
